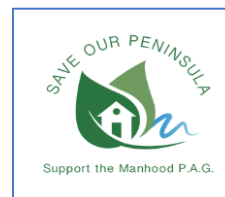

### MPAG Committee Meeting – 7 December 2021 – 18.30 - via Zoom

#### Notes and Action

1. Present. Joan Foster, Ian Sumnall; Keith K Martin; Carey MacKinnon; Louise Goldsmith; Steve Debecker; Paul Bedford; Julie Sabin
2. Apologies for Absence; D. McLean
3. Notes of Last Meeting; Agreed
4. Matters Arising from the Notes
  - a. Protected Status for the Manhood Peninsula – LG – meeting with Chichester Harbour Conservancy. Still trying to make contact.
  - b. CDC's response to flood survey – PB chase with Ray Drabble. Agreed to write to Chair of WSCC Select Committee as to why Manhood is not included
  - c. Population estimates – Chichester and Manhood 2011 and 2020. These have been circulated by Joan.
  - d. Sussex North Water Supply – LG to prepare letter to CDC asking how they are going to respond. Agreed to copy to Southern Water; Chichester Harbour Trust; Susan Taylor and Eileen Lintell at CDC. Agreed to add in Pagham Harbour and raise when funding is going to be made available to Natural England to do the work.
  - e. Invitation to meet with Adrian Moss – Still waiting for dates
  - f. Monitoring of water quality in Pagham Harbour – Request for update from Natural England
5. Improving Local Plan policies – IS mentioned existing Policy 22. Agreed to ask Jane Cunningham for amended policy on ICZM. Manhood Wildlife group have written to CDC about East-West corridor but no reply has been received
6. Chichester District Council have identified a 5-year housing supply. Toby Ayling is leaving CDC on 4 February. Tony Whitty to act for him for six months, whilst new appointments made. LG has drafted letter to CDC re staffing issues in the planning department. Agreed not to go public at this stage
7. Appeal re Church Road, East Wittering development (Welbeck). Two parishes are working together to make joint case. On sewerage and flooding issues MPAG to send letters to members asking them to log instances.
8. Highways England workshop re A27 – ongoing traffic data monitoring. IS is collating data.
9. Environment Bill – Postponed to next meeting

10. Fund-raising – Postponed to next meeting.
11. Website – to discuss resources to improve it, including page to encourage residents to report flooding etc. JF is in touch with company to improve the site. Agreed to allocate £500 for this purpose over next 6 months.
12. Seminar – raise awareness of the Manhood Peninsula – in context of climate change and “Greening the Manhood” JF report on Manhood Wildlife Heritage Group discussion. What should be the focus? LG/JF to discuss further
13. Any Other Business; March for the Manhood will be on 29<sup>th</sup> January
