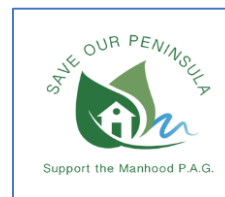

MPAG Committee Meeting – 15 November 2021 – 18.30 - via Zoom

Notes and Action

1. Present: Joan Foster [Chair], David Maclean, Ian Sumnall, Keith K. Martin, Louise Goldsmith; Paul Bedford; Carey MacKinnon;
2. Apologies for Absence - none
3. Minutes of Last Meeting - Agreed
4. Matters Arising from the Minutes
 - a. Protected Status for the Manhood Peninsula – LG – meeting with Chichester Harbour Conservancy - dates are awaited.
 - b. CDC's response to flood survey – PB will chase up Ray Drabble next week
 - c. Population Predictions – JF has spoken to County Councillors and will look at WSCC's response to Hunston's Neighbourhood Plan. Vanessa Cummings is key contact. PB to follow up
 - d. Sussex North Water Supply – LG to prepare letter to CDC asking how they are going to respond. Then look at drafting a press release.
 - e. Invitation to meet with Adrian Moss – waiting for dates
5. Improving Local Plan policies – Discussion about including East-West wildlife corridors in a revised Local Plan. IS to prepare some ideas about how the Local Plan Policy for the Manhood could be improved.
6. Highways England workshop re A27 – A copy of MPAG parishes response was attached to the agenda which had been very useful in providing a co-ordinated approach from the councillors at their workshop. It was agreed that MPAG's role should continue to be one of providing links between the parishes. PB to provide JF with a copy of CDC's background paper on Highways and Transportation. IS to contact Pieter Montyn on traffic count statistics.
7. Environment Bill – DMcL to work with LG on collecting data and evidence about Sewage disposal and discharges including complaints. Refusal of planning application on Clappers Lane seen as a good example of local knowledge having an influence on decision making. Page on EW and B Parish Council website encouraging residents to log incidents seen as another good example, as well as writing to Southern Water. Agreed to hold seminar on the issue. JF to talk to Sam Tate.
8. Fund-raising – Chris Lane has been identified as someone who may be able to help. JF/LG to meet with him before Xmas.

9. Seminar – raise awareness of the Manhood Peninsula – in context of climate change and “Greening the Manhood”. JF to contact Manhood Wildlife Heritage Group to seek their involvement.
10. Any Other Business - D. McL. said that a water quality testing group were involved and view is that situation in Paghham Harbour is being ignored. Wes Smith is involved in this with results of testing due soon. Agreed to raise issue at MPP.
11. IS to send link on National Highways survey to JF.
